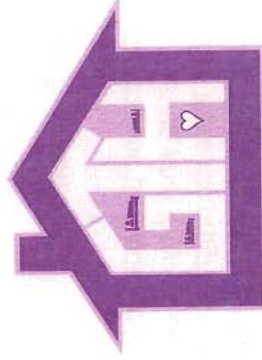

## **God's Treasure House**

...is a Christ-centered transitional living center for women and their children built on a firm foundation of God's love. Our ministry provides a comprehensive aftercare program targeted to a carefully selected number of women returning from jails and prisons to the community. Our goal is to minister to the spiritual, emotional and physical needs of the women, and their children, that God sends to us.

### **Program Overview**

The program is a nine to eighteen month process in three phases. Along with the phase training, the women must be involved in Celebrate Recovery, individual counseling, meetings with a Mentor, regular church attendance and Bible Studies.

#### **Phase I - (3-6 months)**

Begins with orientation and evaluation of their personal needs, spiritually, emotionally and physically. Setting short term goals and restoring family relationships is the starting point of the resident's process. By the end of this phase the resident should be gainfully employed and self supporting.

#### **Phase II - (3-6 months)**

Our residents expand their goal-setting to long-term goals such as what they are going to be doing when they leave the program. They work on budgeting, meal preparation and other basic life skills that help them adapt when they return to the community.

#### **Phase III - (3-6 months)**

In this phase residents implement the goals that were set for their departure such as finding housing and beginning their new life in the community.

All applications are submitted by the residents. Once applications are received, the residents go through the screening process established by God's Treasure House Board of Directors.

*How it all began ... On April 14, 1974 a special friend shared Jesus with me and I gave my heart to Him, yet I struggled to get over the bitterness, anger, and unforgiveness I held in my heart against those who had hurt me.*

*I began work at the Christian Broadcasting Network (700 Club) in Virginia beach, Va. as Administrative Assistant to the Vice President of International Ministries and then started CBN Travel and became their General Manager. It was while I was there that I made wrong choices that would send me to prison.*

*I can say today that prison was the most awesome experience of my life because that is where God set me free, once and for all, from the chains of unforgiveness, hatred, and bitterness towards those who had hurt me and kept me bound for many years. God didn't send me to prison; wrong choices did, but God turned it around for His glory.*

*In prison I cried out to the Lord for direction and purpose. Alone in a prison cell He gave me a scripture verse and a vision from Isaiah 45:3 that gave birth to God's Treasure House, "I will give you the treasures of darkness, riches stored in secret places, so that you may know that I am the Lord, the God of Israel who calls you by name." That vision came to fruition when God's Treasure House opened on January 6, 2006.*

*When I first came to know Jesus as my Savior and Lord I asked Him for two things: if He would ever send me a new husband I wanted him to love God more than me and I wanted to go on the mission field. He answered both. He gave me my husband John who loved God more than me and a mission field that surpasses all mission fields that I could ever dream of being on - one that brought deliverance, peace, and joy beyond all my expectations.*

*Recently widowed, I was the wife of Evangelist John Stocker for 32 wonderful years. I am also the mother of 5 beautiful children, 17 grandchildren, and 4 great grandchildren whom I love dearly! Today I am the Executive Director of God's Treasure House. TO GOD BE THE GLORY!!!*
